



Over the years Franny's Shawl members began knitting mini shawls and the response has been overwhelming. Under the guidance of Dana Leach, little baskets of mini shawls are placed in the church, chapel and Op Shop and are being refilled constantly. A tag is attached to each mini with the message: "This mini Prayer shawl is a symbol of God's Grace, Peace and Love. Keep it in your pocket, reach in and touch it when you are lonely or need comfort.
